Marine Views Cottesloe - Frequently Asked Questions



We have made a list of some frequently asked questions and their answers about moving to Marine Views Cottesloe. Please take a moment to have a read.

Q: When are you holding tours for residents and families to view Marine Views Cottesloe?

A: Tours start this week! If you have yet to book a time, please contact us on 6458 7555 and we will be sure to make a time for you.

Q: When do I need to start preparing myself or my loved one to move?

A: Now is a good time to start thinking about what you would like to take with you to your new home. You may like to use this an opportunity to undertake a bit of a clean-out! You can use your existing furniture or use our new king single electric bed, bedside chair, bedside table, and visitor chair. Your suite also has built in cabinetry with a wardrobe, desk and a wall mounted TV. You can rent or purchase additional items including lounge furniture for premium suites, or a fridge.

Please note, you will not be able to take your existing fridge or TV.

Q: Who will be helping me move?

A: A Curtin Heritage Living team member will assist you and your family. They will help with sorting, packing and unpacking.

Q: How can family members assist?

A: Family members are encouraged to assist residents with packing. We will also have a team member allocated to each resident to assist and will have plenty of packing boxes. We will assist residents across to Marine Views on the day and will help with unpacking.

Q: Will all Wearne residents move on the one day?

A: No. Residents will move over three days. Residents living on level one will move on Wednesday December 1, level two on Thursday the 2nd, and level three on Friday the 3rd.

Q: Will you providing us with details such as the time we will be moving?

A: Absolutely. We will make sure you and your loved ones know the plan for the day of your move. We will be sending a detailed letter to residents and family (by email) in the first week of November.

Q: I have other questions. Who should I contact?
