Let's begin with resident rooms.

Our new rooms will be modern, roomy and most importantly, comfortable. Each room will have its own entry and beautiful private (heated) ensuite. There will be plenty of space to add personal touches - favourite ornaments, family photos and more. The rooms have high ceilings making them feel light and airy.

Each room will have an electronic king-single bed, in-built cabinetry including a wardrobe, and desk. There will be designer furniture pieces, such as a luxury armchair and visitor chair. Residents will always be able to control the room temperature with individually controlled air-conditioning, and double glazed windows that can be opened to enjoy the sea breeze.

The room decor will be beautifully finished with floor to ceiling sheers and drapes, and feature wallpaper above a luxury bedhead.

Residents will be able to watch favourite movies and television programs on a 50" smart TV. Each room has Wifi internet connection, in-room phone and points to charge phones and other devices. Our advanced falls detection, monitoring system and nurse call system will provide peace of mind knowing help is close by.

Each household will have a large open plan lounge area with stylish and comfortable furnishings.

Changes to funding for residential aged care

You may remember receiving an email from us about a change to the funding model for residential aged care. The new funding model, the Australian National Aged care Classification (AN-ACC) will come in to effect on 1 October 2022.

The new funding model promises to deliver funding that is better matched to resident needs. As part of the change, we wanted to remind you that you may need to provide information to us or an AN-ACC representative about what activities you can undertake independently and those you may need support with.
