COVID-19 Update

Masks: As per the latest advice from the State Government, masks must still be worn in public indoor spaces, public transport and ride-sharing services and large outdoor events.

Inside our Curtin Heritage Living homes, all staff and visitors are required to wear face masks.

COVID-19 Vaccination: While not yet mandatory we have received evidence of COVID-19 vaccination from many visitors. The best way to submit your evidence is by bringing your evidence when you check-in (a staff member will need to verify the evidence) or by uploading your evidence using the visitor booking system available at:

COVID-19 booster - On site clinic information

As you may be aware, the ATAGI (Australian Technical Advisory Group on Immunisations) has recommended that eligible people receive a COVID-19 booster vaccination. Those eligible include anyone aged 18 years and older who completed their primary course of COVID-19 vaccinations five or more months ago.

Every eligible resident living or staff member working in an aged care facility will be offered a Pfizer vaccine booster dose.

Curtin Heritage Living consenting residents and staff can receive a booster vaccine at an in-reach clinic at our Marine Views Cottesloe home. The details for the clinic are:

Date: Mon 17 Jan

Time: From 8:30am

Location: Marine Views Cottesloe - level two in The Pavilion

Please note: *you do not need to wait for this clinic to get your booster dose if you are eligible. You can receive your booster at multiple locations in the community.*

Bookings and completion of consent forms prior to the Marine Views clinic are essential.

Details and consent forms will be emailed to residents, representatives and staff separately.
