Waterfront Cottesloe Stage Two

Curtin Heritage Living recently embarked on the second stage of our iconic Cottesloe site. In this stage, there will be more independent living apartments, a restaurant/café, medical centre, arts precinct, cinema and several community activity and meeting spaces.

Demolition of the non-heritage buildings is now complete, and the site is being prepared for excavation. Piling (drilling reinforcement concrete pillars) will commence this week. Work on the heritage building has now also commenced, with all non-heritage items being removed. Wall reinforcement will commence in the coming weeks before new roofs are installed.
