We are delighted to welcome Chris Minchin to the Curtin Heritage Living team as Shine's new Head of Home and Community.

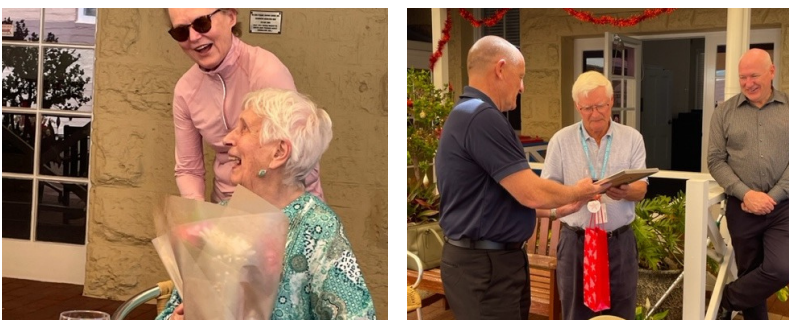

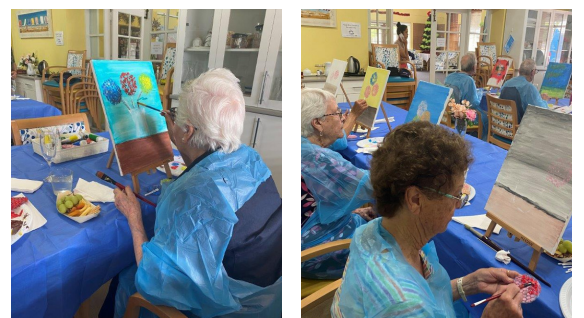


Acknowledging our wonderful volunteers
